

Checklist for Land, Grazing and Farming Disputes Hearings at the District Level

1. Required Documents

- A. Compliant Form (must be typed).
- B. Copy of Grazing/Land Use Permit/Homesite Lease or other vital documents.
- C. Current and last years livestock inventory (Tally Count).
- D. Map of Disputed Area.
- E. Other Supporting Documents from Complainant which states Their position to prove their case.

2. Complaints and respondents and all parties must be at all scheduled hearings and /or mediations.

3. These documents will be made in three (3) sets to be distributed to the following:

- A. District Grazing Committee, Land Board or Farm Board Chairperson.
- B. District Grazing Committee, Land Board or Farm Board Member assigned.
- C. Navajo Department of Agriculture; original Form 1.

Note: All checklist required documents mentioned above must be checked off before the District Grazing Committee/Eastern Land Board or Farm Board can hear your case.
