**NAVAJO NATION FAIR OPEN SENIOR LIVESTOCK AND HORSE
SHOW**

RULES AND REGULATIONS

CLASS LIST AND PREMIUMS

PURPOSE: To provide a venue and an opportunity for breeders of livestock on the Navajo Nation, as well as Navajos residing off the Navajo Nation to show their livestock.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to know all the rules of the show applicable to their events.
2. Exhibitors must be a member of the Navajo Tribe or married to a Navajo.
3. **OWNERSHIP:** All Livestock and horses must be the property of the exhibitors and exhibitors must show proof of ownership upon request. (bill of sale, registration papers, grazing permits, hauling permits)
4. Animals must be free of contagious diseases, clean, groomed and in show condition. The coordinator reserves the right to refuse entry of stock from competition that is not in their judgment in suitable condition or show unruly tendencies that could be hazardous to the public. Health Certificate required upon entering the fair grounds.
5. Livestock and Horses will be **checked in on the following date and times.** Livestock and Horses will be assigned pens.
Cattle, sheep and Horses: Tuesday September 06, 1:00 pm. To 7:00 pm.
Horses not staying on the premises can arrive on the day of the show.
6. Livestock can only be entered in one class. Six (6) entries limited per individual, ranch and farm per species.
7. **ENTRY FEES:** No refunds on entry fees
Sheep: \$ 10.00 Cattle: \$ 15.00 Horses: \$ 20.00
All entry fees must be paid in cash or money order payable to the Nation Fair: No personal checks will be accepted.
8. Decisions of the judge/judges are final in all matters of classification and placing.

9. **The Open Horse Show will begin Wednesday, September 07, at 9:00 am. and Judging for cattle and Sheep will begin at 2:00 pm on the same day.**
10. Exhibitors are required to tend to their animals while on exhibit and to have them presented to the Judges when called for. Any exhibitor who fails to present his/her animal when the class is called will be disqualified from the competition.
11. Exhibitors must wear western or traditional apparel or will be disqualified.
12. Exhibitors will be responsible for feed, feeding/watering, general care, cleaning and showing. Exhibitors must provide containers for feed and water throughout the fair.
13. Exhibitors are encouraged to place signs on those animals that should not be pestered especially stallions and bulls. Unruly stallions and bulls must not be left unattended for the safety of the general public. Exhibitors will be asked to remove any uncontrollable animals.
14. All Livestock class winners (1st to 3rd places) are encouraged to remain on exhibit until 7:00 pm Saturday, September 09, 2011.
15. If there is question on the age of an animal, a Veterinarian will age the animal and that decision will be official.
16. AQHA Rules will apply in the horse classes.
17. Registration will be taken up to an hour before the show; owners must show proof of ownership. (Breed registration papers, bill of sale, etc.)
18. The Navajo Nation Fair requires a negative Coggins test and health certificates for all horses.
19. All horses will be led and shown in the ring, including foals and colts.
20. All exhibitors are encouraged to clean their assigned pens when livestock are released.
21. The Open Sr. Livestock Show Committee will not be responsible for accidents and injuries' to livestock while on the grounds.
22. Exceptions to the above rules will be at the discretion of the Coordinator.
